

IMPORTANT SAFETY WARNINGS



Wessex machines are guarded for your protection, but you must always observe certain elementary precautions. Machines are potentially **dangerous** and should be used with the greatest respect and **ALL OPERATORS MUST** read this manual and be are aware of all safety precautions.

- NEVER run pump dry.
- 2. ALWAYS operate in a well ventilated area.
- 3. Operate on a level surface.
- 4. **ALWAYS** drain pump and remove the breather plug if likely to freeze.
- 5. **ALWAYS** flush with clean water after use.
- 6. Be aware of hot exhaust.
- 7. Salt water should not be left in the pump for extended periods.
- 8. The mixer is not suitable for brown rock salt.
- ONLY use granular salt.
- 10. **ALWAYS** use suitable protective clothing.

WARRANTY

Your Wessex product or equipment is warranted free from defect in workmanship or manufacture for one year from date of purchase. Any parts which appear to us to be defective, either in material or workmanship shall be replaced or repaired at no cost to the purchaser, subject to the following conditions:

- The registration card enclosed with this booklet must be returned to us within seven days of purchase.
- 2. Any failure in the machine should be reported in the first instance immediately to your dealer, who will act on your behalf to resolve the matter to your satisfaction.
- 3. The defective parts will be returned by your dealer to us, accompanied by a full statement describing the failure and the circumstances and conditions in which the failure occurred.
- 4. The following are specifically excluded from our terms of warranty:
 - a) Fair wear and tear, especially to belts, brushes, blades and spinners.
 - b) Damage to blades or brushes caused through incorrect positioning of the rotor (see instructions).
 - c) Damage caused by neglect or lack of lubrication.
 - d) Damage caused by misuse or abuse.
 - e) Damage caused whilst the machine is in transit.
 - f) Damage caused to the frame of the machine by running the machine with unbalanced rotors, blades or spinners.
 - g) Damage caused to the machine by use with loose nuts, bolts, screws or any other type of fittings.
- 5. The warranty is for the benefit of the first user only.
- 6. Wessex International decisions will be final and binding.

Note:

It is recommended that every machine is inspected after one hour of operation to check that all nuts, bolts, screws or any other types of fixings are tight and any loose fixings or components should be rectified as appropriate.

Further inspections should be carried out at regular intervals thereafter.

MIXING THE BRINE

- The mixing ratio of the salt and water will be recommended by the salt supplier/manufacturer.
- Having arrived at the correct mixing percentage, fill the salt tank to the desired level, on the guide marker on the tank.
- IMPORTANT only use Granular Salt never use Rock Salt.
- Close the balance tap at the bottom of the water tank before filling with water, then fill to the desired level to achieve the recommended mixture.
- Having filled both tanks you are now ready to mix.
- Before staring the engine / pump make sure that you are in a well ventilated area to avoid a build up of harmful fumes from the engine.
- Start the engine following the Engine Manufacturers Instructions (see Owners Manual).
- Once the engine / pump is operating, the water will circulate through the salt tank, and back into the water tank until the salt is completely dissolved, this process may take up to 50-60 minutes.
- To be 100% sure of the strength of the mixture, you may decide to buy a Refractometer to check the solution strength.
- Before refilling the salt tank, open the balance tap to drain all fluid from the salt tank, then close before mixing.
- Keep the balance tap closed while mixing.

DISPENSING THE BRINE SOLUTION

- Having mixed the brine solution to your desired strength, you are now ready to dispense it into your sprayer.
- Insert the dispensing nozzle into your sprayer and pull the trigger until you have your desired quantity of brine mixture in your sprayer tank.
- Having dispensed the mixture into your sprayer you do not need to leave the engine / pump running, stop the engine.
- To dispense the next lot of brine simply restart the engine / pump and dispense into your sprayer.

CLEANING YOUR MIXER

- Do not leave brine mixture in the pump for extended periods of time.
- To clean the mixer, simply fill with clean water and circulate for a few minutes to flush the mixer through, then drain out completely.
- Wash off any salt or salt water with clean water.
- In freezing conditions never leave water in the pump, always remove the breather plug from the pump.
- To drain the mixer, disconnect the pump intake and open the balance tap, and it will drain completely.

MAINTENANCE

- See Honda Owners Manual for Engine and Pump maintenance.
- Wash all salt and salt water off brine mixer with plenty of clean water.
- Flush through brine mixer with clean water after use.
- Remove the breather plug from the pump if likely to freeze.


